- What to do to avoid...

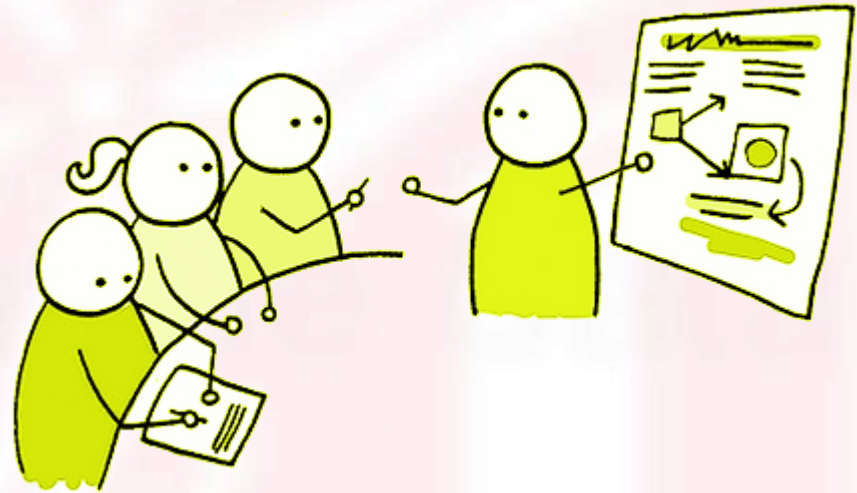


Brainstorming: more ideas...

- Evaluation tool
 - Programs/Projects
 - Process
 - Outcomes
 - Individuals
 - For drug staff (aging, Daily Life Activities)
 - Quality of Life
 - Residences/Housing → drug dependence
 - Specific tools to assess Cognitive Deterioration & other Health Conditions

Brainstorming: more ideas...

- Curricula for training
 - Inpatient/Outpatient & Harm Reduction – staff
 - Geriatric facilities – staff
- Policy recommendations



Methodology

- **Matrix** (M14 → Oct'17)
 - Elements/Headers/focus of the toolbox → discuss about languages
- Integrate data from **previous IO**: Assessment, National Reports & Best Practice Collection.
- Expert consultation & input from all partners.
- Turn the findings into a practical guidance, for instance a website with thumbnails and docs, references, media info., etc.

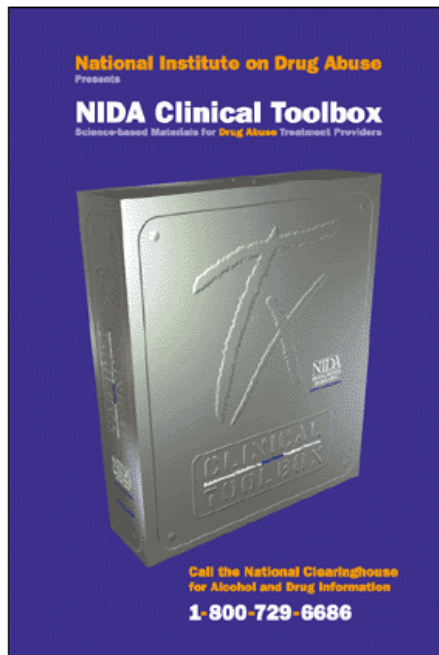
